

## Goldenview PTSA Memory Book Cover Contest

The Goldenview PTSA is sponsoring a contest to choose the cover for the 2017-2018 Memory Book. The cover will be a full color photographic reproduction that wraps around the hardcover volume.

The contest is opened to ALL Goldenview Students. All entries are due to the art teacher, Mrs. Ellinwood by **November 13<sup>th</sup>**. There will be no late submissions allowed.

All Goldenview students will be able to vote by ballot for their top three entries during lunch period on **November 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup>**.

- Every participant will be required to use the honor system and not try to solicit votes for their artwork. All artwork should be anonymous to voting students.
- **Any student who is caught soliciting votes for their artwork will be disqualified.**

The final top three entries will then be presented to the Principal, the Goldenview PTSA President and another designated staff member, who will then pick the winning cover, the second place winner and the third place winner for this year's memory book. We will announce the winner of the Memory Book cover over the intercom by **November 17<sup>th</sup>**.

The winning artwork will have their picture published as the 2015-2016 Memory Book Cover. In addition, the winning entrant will also receive a \$40 gift certificate to Blaine's Art Supply, the second place entrant will receive a \$30 gift certificate to Blaine's Art Supply and the third place entrant will receive a \$20 gift certificate to Blaine's Art Supply.

Below are the rules and specifications for this contest:

1. The image area for the essential art must be 18" X 12" – with the spine of a hardcover book included. **Remember that it will wrap around the front and the back, and the front is on the RIGHT hand side.**
2. Lettering will be added later by the Publisher, so consider this in your design.
3. Include school colors – yellow, purple and black. Other colors may also be used, but our Goldenview colors should stand out! Remember our mascot is the Sun. Metallic colors may NOT be used.
4. Suggestion of possible themes includes unity, or school spirit etc....NO depictions of couples such as boyfriend/girlfriend, or a single person.
5. Plan for the binding. It will be approximately a ½ " in thickness.
6. Any media may be used, having said that, acrylic paints will provide the most solid, uniform and durable color. Other possibilities would also include the following...colored marker, black sharpie, collage, colored pencil, or tempura paint. Questions...ask Mrs. Ellinwood.
7. Be sure your name is on the **BACK** of your entry – **DO NOT PUT YOUR NAME ON THE FRONT**. The judging **MUST** be anonymous.
8. The art room will be opened to all students at lunch that would like to work on their entries. Mrs. Ellinwood is happy to check out supplies to any student(s) who would like to borrow supplies to take home so they can work on their entries. Mrs. Ellinwood will also provide the right size and type of paper; stop by the art room.
